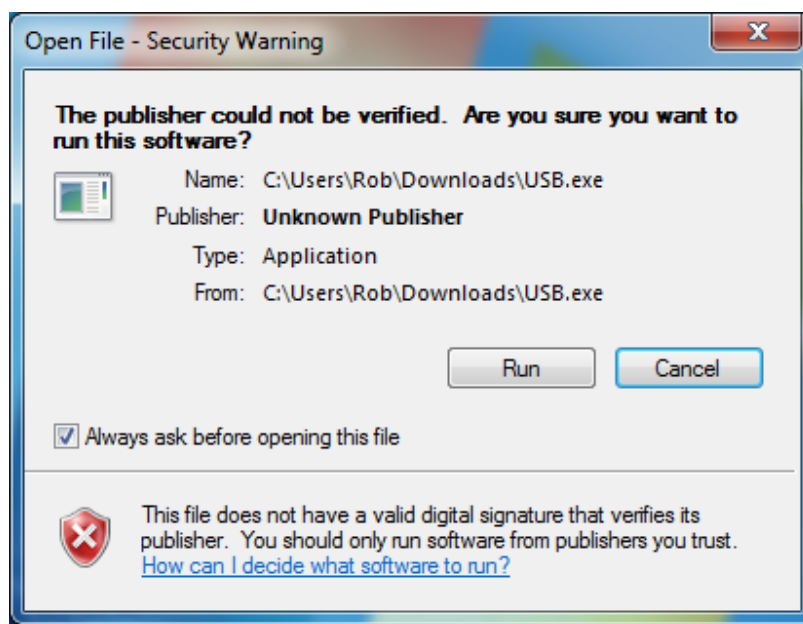


Installing AMBrc USB Driver on 32 bit Windows 7

The USB Driver will not work with 64 bit Windows. There is no 64 bit drivers available. If you have the AMBrc2 Decoder (shown on the left) and 64 bit Windows 7 64 bit you can connect it via a serial port. Most Laptops do not have a serial port. We can supply a USB Serial port adapter that works on Windows 7 64 bit.

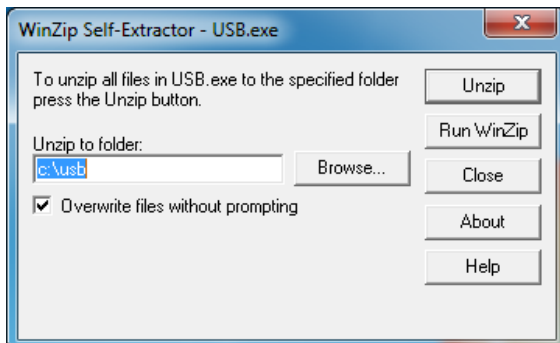


Download and run the USB Driver for AMBrc Decoder from www.bbkssoftware.com bbkRC Software Downloads. When you run the download you will see the following Screen.

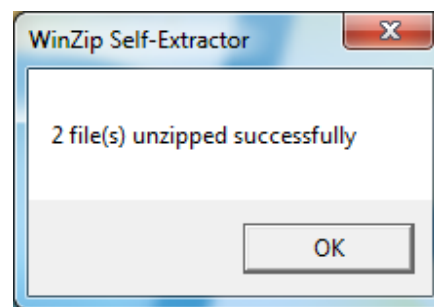


Click Run.

The next screen you will see is.

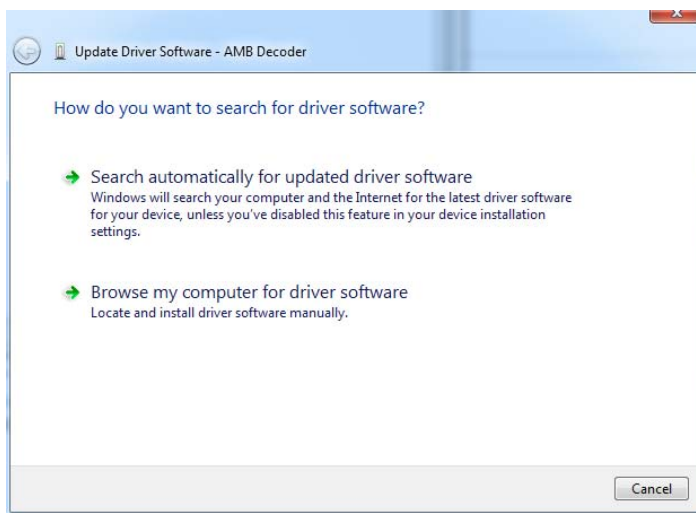


Click **Unzip** and you will see screen.



Next attach the RC2 Decoder to a USB Port. If the AMBrc USB Driver is not installed correctly you will see an unknown device in the Device Manager. To view Device manager Press the **Start Button**, Right Mouse Click **Computer**, Select **Properties** and select **Device Manager** from the top left of the screen.

Select **Unknown Device**, right mouse click and select **Update Driver**.



Select Browse my Computer and locate the AMB directory in the root of the C:\ driver.

Click **Next** and the driver will be installed.
